**Registration:** Please register by contacting the Commodore or Fleet Captain, via email, no later than Thursday, June 4.

**Start:** Between the orange flag on the committee boat and Nun 2 at the entrance to Lloyd Harbor.

**Finish:** Between the orange flag on the committee boat and Nun 2 Lloyd Harbor.

**Course:** The course shall be signaled from the committee boat using letter placards:

A- flasher G1 off Sand City to Port, Bell 8 Target Rock to Port, finish 3.3 nm.

B- reverse of course A.

**Scoring:** PHRF Time on Distance.

**Sails:** This is a jib and main race. No spinnakers of any variety may be used. Whisker poles of any length are permitted.
